About the Play

The Crucible is a 1953 play by American playwright Arthur Miller. It is a dramatised and partially fictionalised story of the Salem witch trials that took place in the Massachusetts Bay Colony during 1692–93. Many of the names used in the play were real people but the relationships are fictional. Miller wrote the play as a protest about the McCarthy administration and their persecution of people accused of being communists in the 1950's.

Act 1 Scene 2 – John Proctors House, 8 days later.
